### All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Rajkot (Gujarat) Department of Anatomy Poster/Chart competition cum Exhibition on 'Thoracic viscera and related neuro-vascular structures'

## **Summary Report of Poster/Chart competition**

The Department of Anatomy, AIIMS Rajkot conducted a Poster/Chart competition cum exhibition on **'Thoracic viscera and related neuro-vascular structures'** on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2022 from 10.00 AM to 16.00 PM. **Professor Col. Dr. CDS Katoch**, Executive Director, AIIMS Rajkot was the Chief Guest and Patron of the event. The program was conducted under the guidance of Organizing Chairperson **Dr. Simmi Mehra**, Professor & Head, Department of Anatomy; and Co-ordinated by **Dr. Sundip Charmode** Associate Professor, Department of Anatomy, AIIMS Rajkot. They were assisted by Dr. Shalom Philip, Senior resident, Miss Bhumika, Miss Heena and Mr. Yashraj in the various activities.

**Objective of the Competition:** The objective of this competition was to emphasise the clinical importance and conceptual visualization of thoracic viscera and related neuro-vascular structures to the first-year MBBS students, thereby instilling a clinical-oriented learning approach.

#### **Program details:**

All the First year MBBS students were divided in 14 groups. Each group, comprising of 3-4 students, was allotted a topic for model/chart preparation. All the students (group wise) were stationed along with their respective models/charts in the Dissection hall and Histology laboratory of the Department of Anatomy. All the faculty members, residents and the 2<sup>nd</sup> year students were invited for the event.

The program started at 11.00 am by a warm welcome to the Chief Guest and all the judges by **Dr. Simmi Mehra**, Professor and Head, Department of Anatomy, AIIMS, Rajkot.

The program was inaugurated by **Professor Col. Dr. CDS Katoch, Executive Director AIIMS Rajkot**.

**Professor Col. Dr. CDS Katoch**, the Chief Guest, interacted with each group of students, asking them clinical questions regarding their models/charts. He discussed various interesting cases thus sharing his vast knowledge of the subject with the students and faculty in attendance. He recommended that all departments must adopt a clinical-oriented teaching curriculum focusing to enhance students' basic/fundamental skills to enable them to deal with clinical cases in their final years of education.

This was followed by the evaluation of the models and charts. **Dr. Bhavesh Modi**, Professor and Head, Department of CMFM; **Dr. Sanjay Gupta**, I/C Dean (Examination Cell), Professor and Head, Department of FMT and **Dr. Sanjay Singhal**, Vice Dean (Academics), Associate Professor, Department of Pulmonary Medicine were the judges for the evaluation. Each judge assessed the posters/charts and students individually, and grades were assigned based on the students' understanding of the topic, creativity, and presentation skills. **Dr. Simmi Mehra** received the results after they were finalised.






